





Boasting 40 different nationalities, the students, teachers and staff at ISIT are accustomed to studying, thinking and acting from an intercultural perspective.

6 to 12 months of university exchanges



All students spend at least one semester at one of ISIT's international university partners through exchanges facilitated by the European Union's ERASMUS+ programs & other bilateral agreements. These academic mobilities are mandatory in year 3 and optional in year 2. In

exchange, numerous students from partner universities spend one or two semesters studying at ISIT's intercultural campus.

APPLYING TO ISIT

Criteria

- Command of French, English and a third language, to be chosen from Arabic, Chinese, German, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish or Russian. Assessments for other languages may also be arranged at the end of the course.
- Admission into year 1: French baccalaureat or equivalent secondary education diploma
- Admission into year 2: Successful completion of one year of higher education
- Admission into year 3: Successful completion of two years of higher education
- Admission into year 4: Successful completion of three years of higher education
- Admission into year 5: Successful completion of first year of Masters studies

Admissions procedure

- Year 1: Application to be submitted exclusively via the PARCOURSUP platform (under 'Ecoles de commerce' > 'Région Ile-de-France').
- Years 2 & 3: Online application (available at www.isit-paris.fr) followed by multilingual written tests. Students whose preparatory schools have signed agreements with ISIT are exempt from the written tests: under these circumstances, applicants need only submit the online application. List of partner preparatory schools available at www.isit-paris.fr
- Year 4: Online application, multilingual written tests + interviews. Students whose preparatory schools have signed agreements with ISIT are exempt from the written tests and interviews: under these circumstances, applicants need only submit the online application.

ADMISSION TO THE MASTER'S IN CONFERENCE INTERPRETING

Students are only admitted into the first year of the course. There are two stages of entrance tests:

- 1. Pre-admission tests in English & French
- 2. Multilingual entrance exam

Applicants must have spent at least 12 consecutive months in a country where their B language is spoken (6 months recommended for all other languages). During the entrance exams, applicants will be assessed in French, English and any other language(s) that they have fully mastered.

ADMISSION TO THE LAWYER LINGUIST DOUBLE-DEGREE PROGRAM

Applicants must be simultaneously registered to study at a law school in the Paris Ile-de-France area, or already hold a law degree.

ISIT has signed partnerships with two universities: Panthéon-Assas Paris II and the Jean Monnet Law Faculty at the Université Paris Sud.

To apply for entry into first year, students must select their chosen law school and ISIT on the Parcoursup online platform.

HOW TO FINANCE YOUR STUDIES

ISIT is a not-for-profit association registered under French law (Loi 1901) and 80% of our resources come from student tuition fees. To allow everyone the chance to study at our Grande Ecole and to ensure that true social inclusion remains at the heart of our public interest mission, students can opt for a wide range of financing solutions.

As of the academic year 2020 a new fees policy will be implemented based on three guiding principles: moderation, stability and transparency.

From now on, at the start of every academic every student cohort will know in advance how much their fees will be until the end of their studies. Fee rates will be linked to the incoming year group for each year of study, with an identical annual rate for all three undergraduate (pre-Masters level) study year groups and an identical annual rate for the two years of postgraduate study (Masters level). The aim is to enable all students to calculate, anticipate and subsequently manage their overall financial investment towards obtaining their diploma.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT AT ISIT

Tuition Fees Insurance

To help students protect themselves against everyday accidents, ISIT offers a tuition fees insurance at advantageous rates. It enables students to cover their tuition fees in the following circumstances:

- Death
- Economic issues, job loss and loss of revenue of the financial guarantor following a redundancy, illness or accident
- An interruption in academic activities or repetition of an academic year due to a student's illness or an accident
- The basic cost of the insurance for 2020/2021 is € 138. This sum is transferred in its entirety to the insurer and issuer of the contract Gras Savoye.

Grants

ISIT grants

each year, ISIT allocates grants from its own funds to a selection of the most deserving students. Although insufficient to cover the combined cost of tuition fees and student life, these grants can go some way to relieving the burden of these expenses.

Means-tested grants

As ISIT is formally recognised as a Grande École, European ISIT students are entitled to apply for a State-funded higher education grant. The window for applications runs from 15 January to 31 March every year on the CROUS website.

Erasmus+ grants

allocated in the context of an academic exchange or an internship in another European Union country.

Bank loans at negotiated rates

ISIT has negotiated preferential interest rates for its students who take out loans with Banque Populaire, Caisse d'Epargne and Société Générale.
